### Number of Sessions.

Under Better Access to mental Health consumers will attend 6 sessions followed by a review by your GP, to which another 6 sessions may be granted to complete your treatment.

### Session payment options.

**Private.** As per fee schedule.

### Medicare.

Bulk Billed via GP referral.

You will need to visit your GP, Paediatrician or Psychiatrist and speak to reception staff that you would like a GP Mental Health Plan visit 2710 [it is a longer visit].

1. A treatment plan will be discussed.
2. Tell your GP, Paediatrician, Psychiatrist that you would like to see Mark Logan MHSW.
3. Obtain a referral plan 2710 requesting that you wish to commence counselling with Mark Logan of AFFECT Consulting.

*If needed, show this brochure to your GP.*

\*\*note: clients will be charged the first 15 min fee for **Non Attendance** or **cancelations** within 2 hrs of appointment (except family crisis).

If you give enough time, your session can then be allocated to another client seeking counselling.
